Local Coastal Plan (LCP)

Walt presented background information on Oxnard Shore's LCP and reasons for the need to recognize and incorporate it into the City's LCP.

- Property owners gave up half of the land on the beach for public access. However, it was stated that this beach was not appropriate for recreational use. Therefore, in the 1988 agreement, it was stipulated that no restrooms or parking facilities be made available.
- We have requested that the stipulations in this LCP be incorporated into the rules and signage at the beach.
- Also, the City's projections on the rise of sea levels do not take into account relative sea level rise based on local conditions. This difference could have a significant impact on property values. Relative Sea Level rise should be incorporated into the City's LCP.
